Cyberbullying can happen to anyone, at any time, and it can be very harmful.

There are many apps/websites where you can chat with other people online. Some of these are designed for children and young people, but some are not. It's important to be careful when talking to strangers online. Never give out your name, address, phone number, or any other personal information to someone you don't know well. If you're unsure, ask a parent or teacher for help.

**Group Chats**  
Group chats are a way for people to talk to each other online. They can be fun, but they can also be a place where people can be bullied. It's important to be careful when joining group chats. Only join if you know the people who are in the chat, and don't share any personal information.

A fantastic achievement girls, well done from all of us at Istead Rise Primary!




### A very special visit

 After this we explored what 2D shapes we could see within our 3D shapes. We had so much fun using paint to print our 3D shapes onto paper!





**Theme: Julia Donaldson**


## FIRPS Easter Activity



In Maths we have completed our work on fractions, including improper, mixed number and addition and subtraction of fractions, which they have done well at due to their knowledge of times tables.
