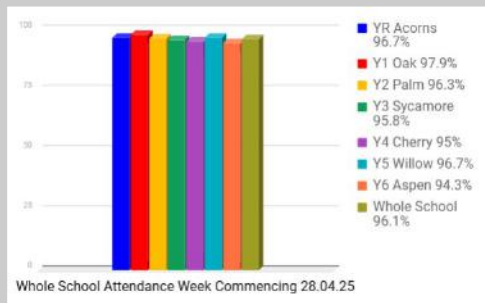
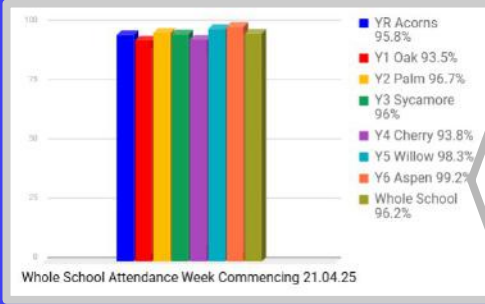

# Mini London Marathon 2025



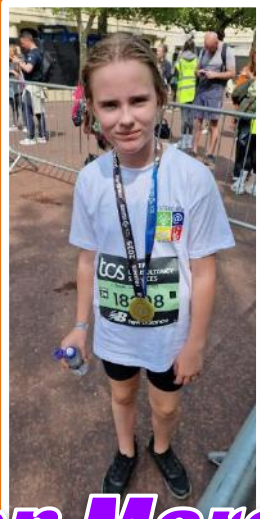

Sycamore Class have made a fantastic start to the term. The children were excited for our new topic in science - plants. They loved identifying the new common house plants and identifying the different parts of a marigold plant. They are all keen to look after our plants until the end of year. They have planted their own spider plant and will hopefully bring them home at the end of term. In English we are carrying on the theme of chocolate. Our sequence of work is an explanation text of how chocolate is made. In maths, we finished our topic on fractions and have gone on to learn about money; how to convert pounds and pence as well as addition and subtraction. In geography, our new topic is about the rainforest. In our first lesson we looked in atlases and learned about the equator and the tropics. In DT we will be learning how to make a castle out of paper.



# Cherry



Last week in English, we completed our narrative 'Attack of the Giant Insects' from last term, with the draft, edit and redraft. Hopefully you have been able to see the storyboard plans the children created as these were sent home at the start of this week. Our next English sequence is a setting description, focusing on descriptive language and fronted adverbials. In Maths, we have been working on decimals, looking at partitioning and ordering. In History, we have started our unit on the History of Dover Castle, looking at the main 3 types of castles in our country, creating a timeline and the reasons why Dover Castle was first built. The children are very excited about our trip to the castle next week, where they will be able to see some of these main features first hand.



In Spanish, we have started looking at the vocabulary for different Spanish foods and how to order them at a cafe. This term in Art, we are looking at influential artists and started looking at the painting 'My Parents' by David Hockney, which the children then had to reproduce.



# Forest School: Cherry

The last two sessions of forest school for Cherry Class were packed with so much fun. The class were extremely sensible when they used the bow saw to cut a piece of wood, and when toasting a tasty treat over the open fire. It has been a real pleasure to teach Year 4 in the forest. The sessions have been packed with so many activities. I hope they all had a well deserved rest over Easter.





To start our World War One topic in history, we took part in a workshop by 'Portals to the Past'. We all had an amazing day trying on military uniform, handling artefacts, taking part in a quiz, marching drills and testing our abilities to be a stretcher bearer. A highlight of the day was taking part in the attack patterns running through smoke screens.

Last week, we had a go at learning: how to throw a discus, hammer throw, javelin and shot put. This week, Year 6 practiced their jumping skills in preparation for the long jump, as well as learning the skill of a 'hop, skip and jump.'

Year 6 SATs are fast approaching (12th - 15th May). Well done to those who have been carrying out extra revision at home - it really helps! If there is anything that you would like for the final push before SATs, please let Miss Waters know. E.g. workbooks, worksheets. Thank you so much for all of your support.
