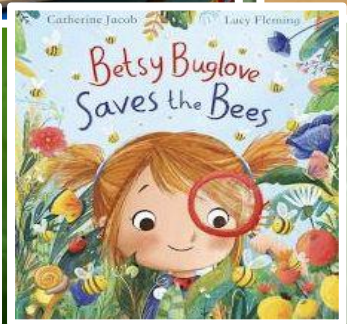
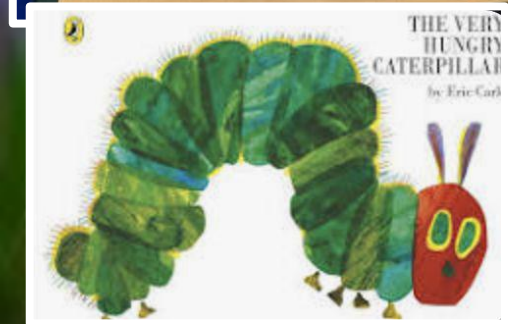
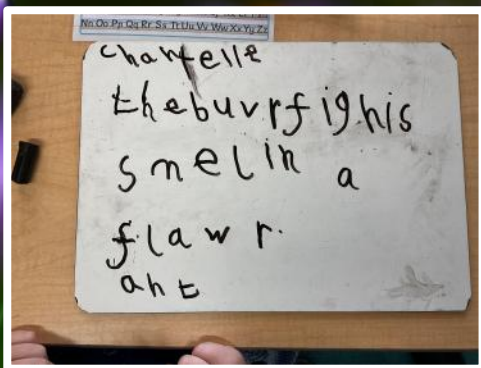
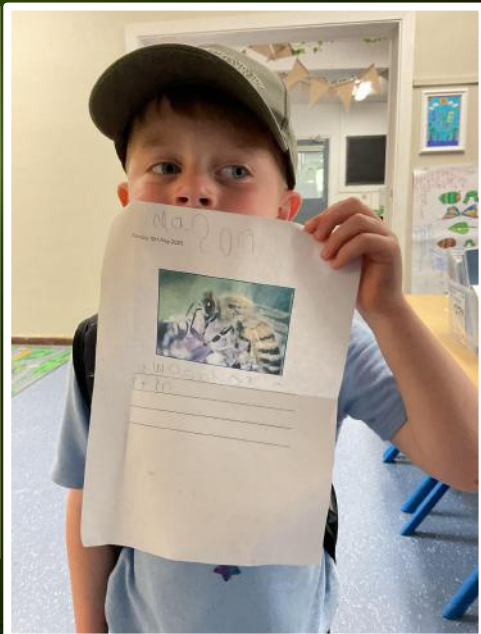
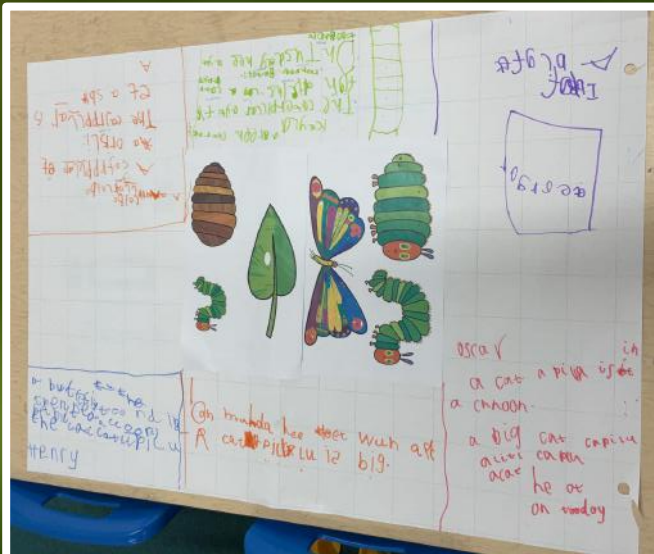
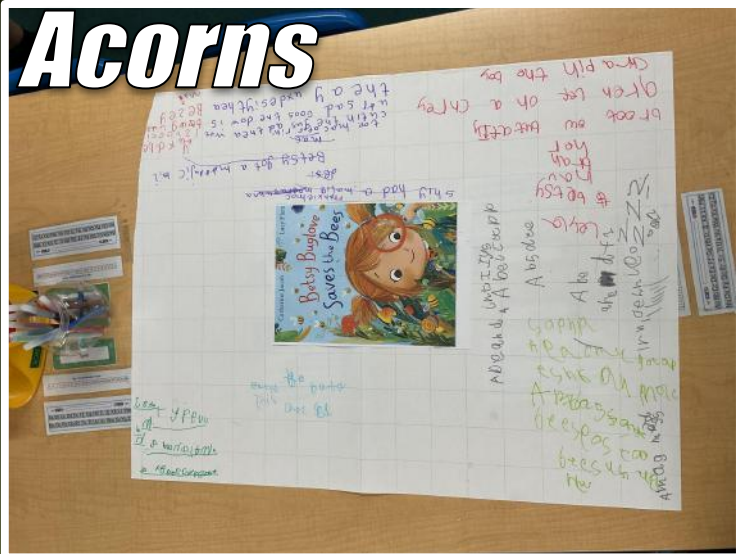




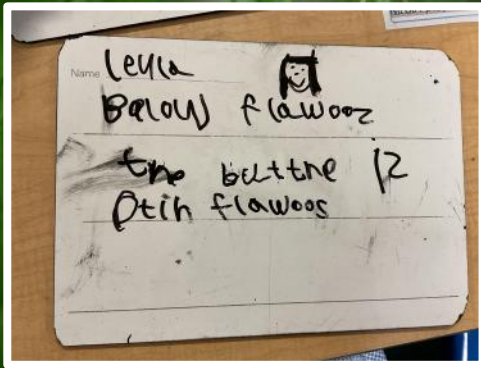
This term some of the children in Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 have taken part in a player development session lead by coaches from Chelsea FC. During the sessions the children worked on their match play, ball skills, as well teamwork and positivity.



Acorns



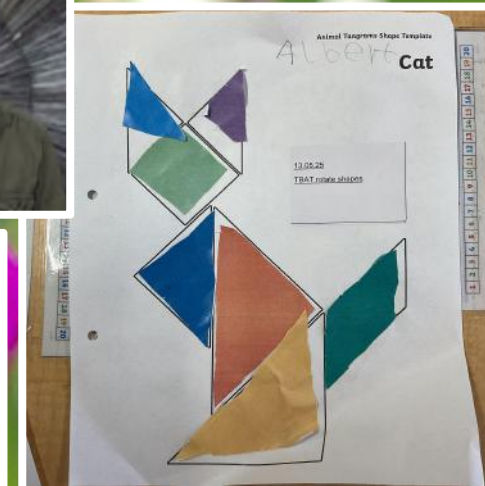
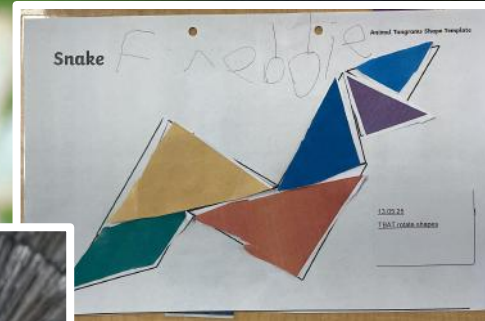
The children have had a super week practising their reading, writing and performing skills. They have sequenced stories, explained how they would save the bees and written their own sentences about the stories.

In maths, the children have been learning about adding and taking away with numbers to 10 by using a ten frame to support them. We have just moved on to looking at 2D shapes and how we can use them to help us in our work. We have looked at rotating and manipulating them into the correct positions on our paper.



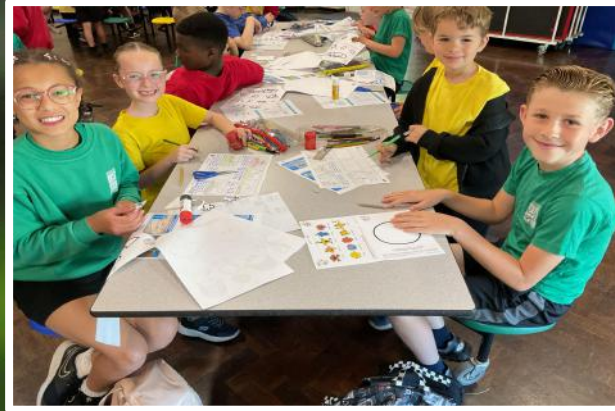
The children have composed a piece of artwork inspired by Andy Goldsworthy. Here are some facts they learnt about him.

- He is a British Artist.
- He used nature to create art.
- He is an environmentalist - meaning he wants to protect the environment around him.



Oak Class have been comparing Victorian and modern toys in History and put them in a timeline. To dive deeper, they had a fantastic Toy Experience workshop. During this workshop, they looked at Victorian toys and discussed how they functioned, they spoke about gravity and push-pull forces, they loved it! The highlight was building their own wooden toys, making a real connection to the toys they learnt about. They've had so much fun while learning!

Palm



This week Palm class has been working alongside Willow class in the KS1 hall to create their very own Mr Men storybooks. The year 5s have been very kind and helpful and the year 2s have really enjoyed working with them. The children in year 2 have also been working hard on fractions in maths and in English are writing a newspaper report about Pocahontas' death in Gravesend in 1617. We have been really impressed with their history work this term too, they've learnt lots about the real Pocahontas and her tribe and why the English colonised America and founded Jamestown.

Sycamore



Sycamore class have had another productive couple of weeks. The children worked hard to complete their explanation texts about chocolate. We finished our maths sequence with money and role played going to the shops, this included buying one or more items and giving change with a partner. We have just started our new topic in maths which is time. In science we have set up an investigation to explore the requirement of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant. We are feeding plants with different foods (salt water, tap water, fertilizer and orange juice) observing and recording results.



It has been a great start to Forest School for Year 3. Our topic this term is Composting. We have been looking at what goes into a compost and how compost is used. In week 1, Sycamore class planted some cress seeds in the bottom half of a recycled plastic bottle - filled with some compost. We will let you know how they grow.

In week 2, we looked at the characteristics of worms and explored how important they are. We learnt that having worms in the soil is a sign that the soil is healthy and great for growing things in. The class had fun searching for 'worms' amongst some compost.

Year 3 also enjoyed looking and exploring mealworms. Mealworms were also used by the class in a cocktail of seeds and oats to make bird feeders, in the top half of a recycled plastic bottle or a cardboard tube. Some of the children hung them up in our new sensory garden. I am sure the birds are going to enjoy the feast the children have made for them. Other activities enjoyed by the class over the last two weeks include; chilling in the hammock, making forest lasagna and mud pies in the mud kitchen as well as making tools and dens. Sycamore class all took part in a worm race where they had to move along the track like a worm.

It's been another very busy time in Year 4. In English we have written setting descriptions, focused on clear use of sophisticated vocabulary and figurative language, which were based on the world of the movie Tron. The children loved exploring what this world was like and the resulting writing was to a very high standard. In Maths we have been looking at money this week, including converting pence to pounds and vice versa. In History we have continued looking at the history and developments of Dover Castle, including our amazing trip to the castle so that we would know the areas and improvements to the castle. It was a great educational visit, even if it was a bit windy! In Spanish we have been learning the names of more food and how to order them at a cafe, while in Art this week we have created a portrait in the style of David Hockney. We have another Emile MTC world cup competition next week, so access to Emile is now open again to the children. Please encourage them to do as much practice on this (or TTRS) as possible, including over the half term, as the real Multiplication Times Table Check is at the start of next term, and continual practice will give them the best shot of doing well under the added pressure of it being the real thing.

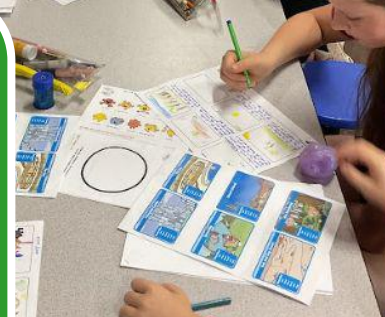

Whilst Year 6 have been using our classroom for their SATs, we had a fantastic time working with the Year 2 children creating our own Mr Men and Little Miss characters. Then we wrote an adventure story for our characters, before creating it into a book.



In PE we have been working on our Athletics skills with Coach James. We have been working on throwing disciplines of shot put, javelin and hammer. We have also been working on our jumping technique for long jump, as well as working on our sprint starts ready for our Sports Day running races.



In English we have just started our learning sequence writing a story about a young boy, who has been called up to service as a WW1 soldier. In Maths we have come to the end of our learning about fractions and decimals and will be moving on to area and perimeter. In history we have continued to learn about WW1, learning about the events that led up to the outbreak of WW1, the main participating countries and identified significant figures and explained how the Russian Revolution and the USA entering the conflict impacted WW1.



Well done to Year 6 for completing their SATs tests this week! Year 6 have worked extremely hard since the start of the school year and we as a school are very proud of them.

They have had a great day today having a superclass and celebration day!

Next week, we will be resuming with our usual lessons and subjects.
