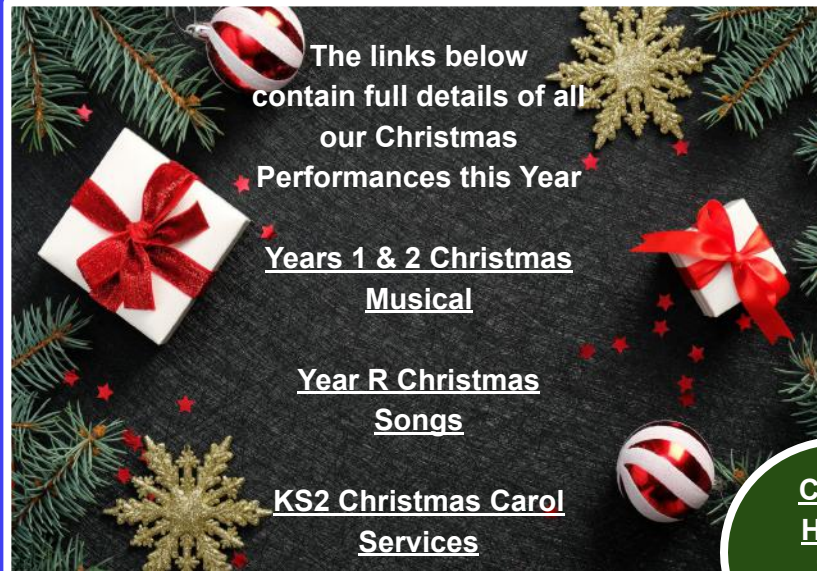

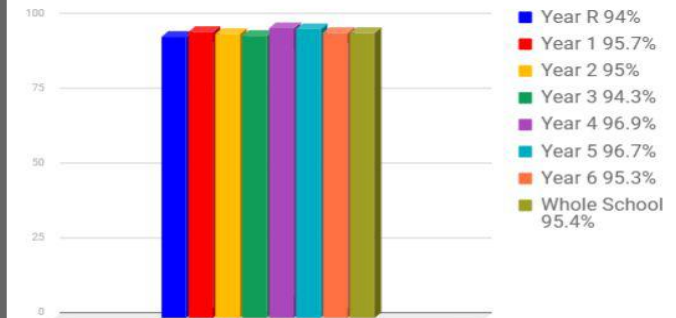

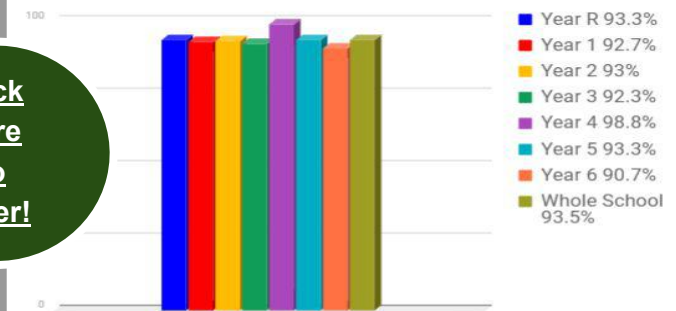

# Year R

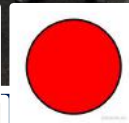
In maths we have been looking at circles and triangles. We went on a hunt in our environment to see if we could spot circles and triangles. We made our own pictures using just these two shapes!

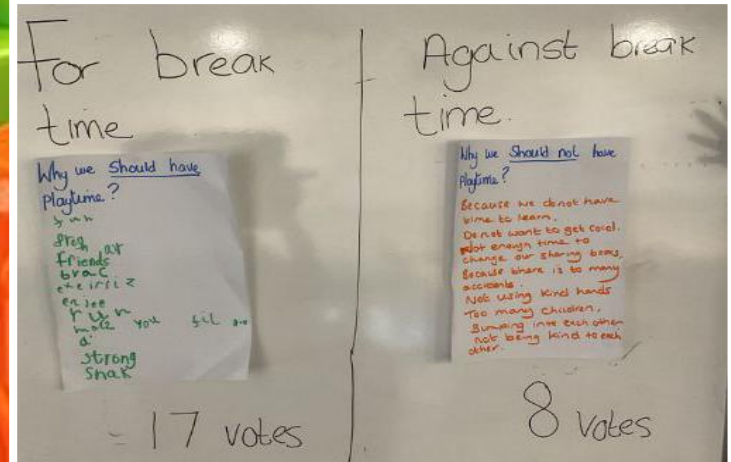

In English, the children finished their imaginative stories and have just started a new sequence of learning which is a recount of their trip to Warner Brother Studios.

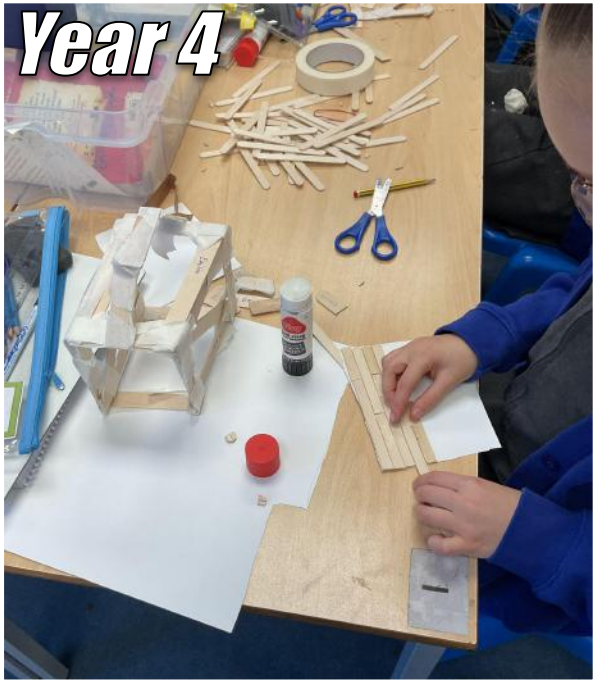

# Year 4

In Maths we have looked at the 11 and 12 times table this week, as well as multiplying by 1 and 0.  
In Science we have completed the core learning in our science unit on electricity and so this week completed our quiz, leaving us a few weeks to further explore circuits and how different components work, including LEDs.

In RE we have looked at a range of different sites of Christian pilgrimage, including a recap on Rome and Canterbury, as well as Lourdes and Bethlehem.

In DT we have continued working on the frames for our structures and some of the children have now started constructing their outer wall. They're going to look great once they are finished!

In History this week we learned how Alfred the Great was able to defeat and then make peace with the Vikings, looking at the evidence to infer what kind of king Alfred was and what he believed in.

And we've also found time to practice our Christmas carols at the end of the week.

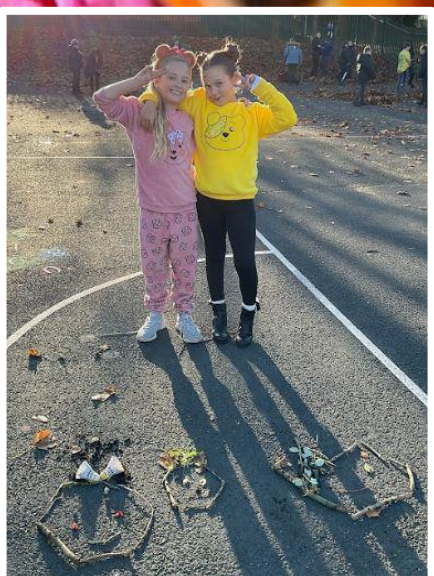

# Year 5



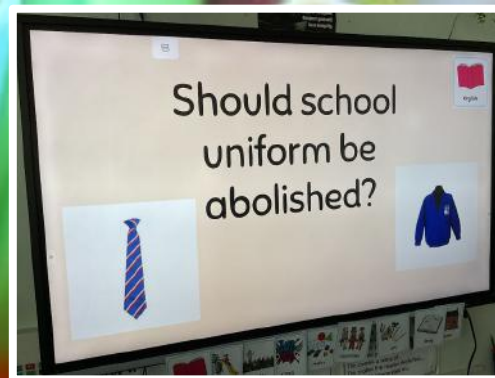
To celebrate 'Outdoor Learning Day' we took our art lesson outside. The children were challenged to create Pudsey, only using natural resources that they could find in the school grounds.

# Year 5



As part of UK Parliament Week, we held a debate in class on whether school uniform should be abolished, took part in Big Ben Bong-O to learn more about the Houses of Parliament and took part in a debate on how we can be more sustainable.



In volleyball with Coach James we have been learning how to spike the ball to get it over the net. We then tried to add in a dig and set that we had learnt in previous lessons to earn points against our opponents.

During our Careers lesson this week, we learnt all about what it takes to be a secondary school teacher. Some of the class took on the role of teacher and taught a small group how to count to 10 in German, it was not as easy as they thought!



# Year 6



Another busy few weeks for Year 6. We have started a new learning sequence in English - we are now writing a diary entry from the point of view of a Victorian child who lives and works in a workhouse. This ties in nicely with our History learning - The Victorians. The children have really enjoyed learning about the Victorians so far and are starting to understand how different life was back then!

In Maths we have been working on learning different methods for fractions. So far, we have learnt how to simplify fractions, convert an improper fraction to a mixed number and back again, and add and subtract fractions. Year 6 have been working incredibly hard on this - well done!

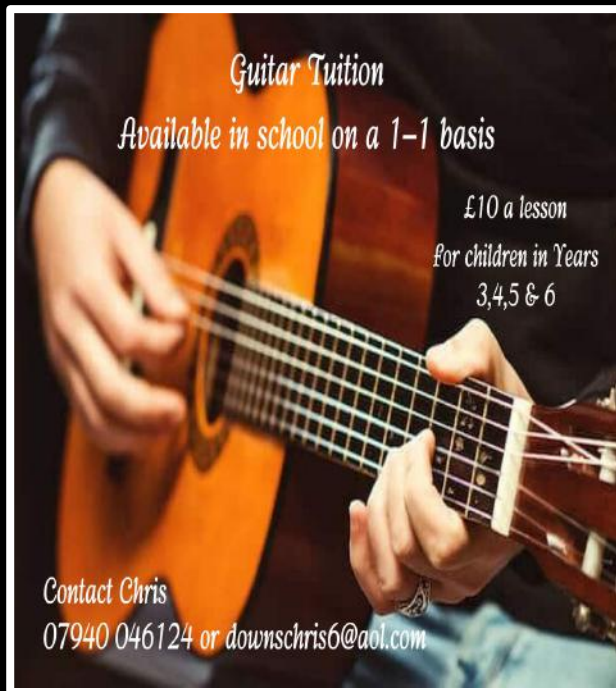
