### Information

**When:** This trip will take place on **Wednesday 11th March 2026**.

**Where:** **Port Lympe Safari Park** Aldington Rd, Lympe, Hythe CT21 4LR

**Timings:** Children should arrive at school by **8:00am**. We plan to leave school by 8:10am and arrive at Port Lympe by approximately 9:00am. This will allow time for parking and toilet trips before departure. Please can children enter school via the office.

**Cost: £23.50 per pupil** this includes the cost of the coach, entrance into Port Lympe and a safari trip.

**Lunch:** Pupils **must bring their own packed lunch** or book a school packed lunch via Parent Pay. Please ensure your child brings a named bag which they can easily carry their lunch in throughout the day. Please do not pack any fizzy drinks or glass bottles.

**Please ensure your child wears school uniform and dresses appropriately for the weather and has suitable footwear (trainers allowed) as this trip will involve a lot of walking and some steep hills.**
