We would like to confirm the arrangements for the week of the SATs; **We ask that ALL children arrive** at school via the office, by 8:00am. If required, siblings may attend the usual school breakfast club during this time (again the cost of this will be covered by the school). Please let the office know in advance if you would like to take up any places at breakfast club during this time.

There will also be a trial run of the breakfast on the morning of Friday 10th May 2024, starting at 8:00am. After breakfast, children will head to class to be registered, ready to start their school day as normal.

Please remember that regular attendance and punctuality are essential, 'every learning minute counts' and we request that all Year 6 children are at school for the above dates.
